A SUMMARY OF OUR GUIDELINES

The West Coast Eagles have been actively supporting the WA community since the club formed in 1986. In that time the club has increased its support of the West Australian community, providing assistance to many charitable groups and strengthening an involvement in many worthwhile community activities, with a particular focus on football development.

Unfortunately, we are unable to assist every worthy cause that requests and needs support and have adopted the following principles as a guide to the selection criteria.

Please note that although your organisation may fall within the categories and guidelines below, we may not be able to support your request due to the overwhelming number of applications we receive each season.

AREAS OF SUPPORT

The programs and areas through which we direct our support are those that relate to one or more of the following categories of community endeavour:

1. Junior football development – support of the game at the grassroots level
2. Youth and education – to help provide a pathway for young people to build purposeful lives as members of the wider community
3. Health and well being – in an effort to improve the health and well being of the community, with a particular focus on illnesses that have an association with the club, its employees, members and supporters

CRITERIA

The West Coast Eagles Football Club is endeavouring to create more programs in community relations that utilise donations as an incentive/enhancement of the program. Therefore, we adhere to the following criteria:

- 1) The club will provide donations where possible but the charity group must address at least one of the categories of community support, being junior football development, youth & education or health & well being.
- 2) The West Coast Eagles is not in a position to offer cash donations or sponsorships.
- 3) Requests for donations will only be accepted during the home and away season.
- 4) The club will not provide donations to individuals.

If you feel that your request falls within all the guidelines outlined, please complete the attached donation request form.

Please be aware that even if your request meets the criteria outlined there is no guarantee that your request will be able to be serviced.

AUTOGRAPHED MATERIAL

Each year the club receives thousands of requests for signed merchandise and auction items for charities, community groups and schools. Because of the huge amount of requests for player autographs, the club enforces a strict policy.

Members and supporters are encouraged to attend open training sessions (which are posted on the club website at westcoasteagles.com.au or can be obtained by contacting reception on 08 9381 1111). Under no circumstances can merchandise be sent or left at the club for signing.

AVAILABILITY

During the off-season (October-February) requests for donations are generally not able to be serviced.
